DANIEL PATRICK McCANN

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Retired Master Sgt. Daniel Patrick McCann, died peacefully at home surrounded by his family in Autaugaville, Alabama on Tuesday, May 24, 2016. He was 80 years old, dearly loved by all who knew him and generously gave to all he knew.

The celebration of Dan's life will be held at Prattville Memorial Chapel on Thursday, May 26, 2016 with Pastor Bruce Still officiating. Visitation will be held at 5:00 p.m. followed by a memorial service at 6:00 p.m. Dan was preceded in death by his daughter, Cathleen McCann. He is survived by his loving wife of 43 years, Nancy McCann and children: Dianna Eitel of Aiken, South Carolina; Patricia (Mike) Neal of Aiken, South Carolina; Daniel S. McCann (Mari) of Layton, Utah; Darlene (Steve) Jackson of Prattville, Alabama; Colleen Anderberg of Raleigh, North Carolina; Angela (Daniel) Pezzulo of Lancaster, Pennsylvania; Seventeen grandchildren; eleven great-grandchildren; one brother, Frank McCann of Maynard, Massachusetts and many extended friends and family.

Born in 1936 in Groton, Massachusetts, Dan enlisted in the Air Force in 1954. His service career allowed him to proudly serve his country and embrace his love of flight, travel and electronics, including his assignment as an experimental rocket engine mechanic of the North American X-15 hypersonic rocket-powered aircraft at Edwards AFB, California in 1966, and as a Vietnam Veteran in 1972. After his retirement from the Air Force in 1974 at Maxwell-Gunter Air Force Base in Montgomery, Alabama, Dan continued to share his many gifts with others in Prattville as Innkeeper of the Holiday Inn; the owner of Dan's Help Desk; and Past Master of Masonic Lodge #89.
