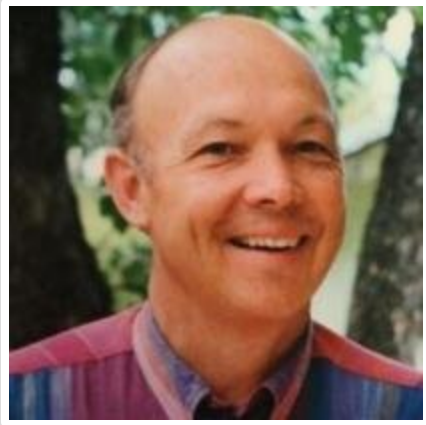




Don Pace
