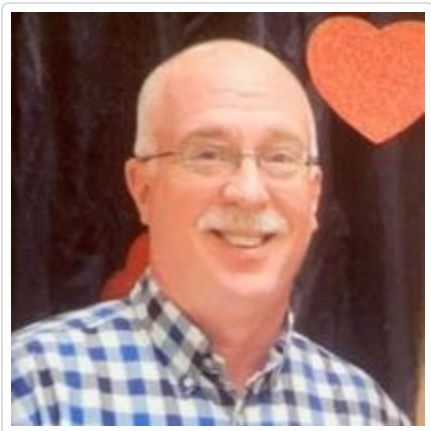




Douglas James Moore

MOORE, DOUGLAS JAMES, 59, of Millbrook, AL passed away on the morning of Thursday, September 9, 2021, after a recent illness. Doug was born September 30, 1961 in Montgomery, Alabama to the late Lettie Steineck Beasley and James Russell Moore. Doug graduated from Jefferson Davis High School in 1980 and went on to work fulltime at the Alabama Department of Transportation for 30 years, from 1984 – 2014, as a Distributed Systems Specialist and then an IT Systems Specialist, Associate. He worked an additional 6 years as a retired state employee for the same department, from 2015 - 2021. Doug was a vital, active member of Heritage Baptist Church, Prattville AL.
