Helena, AL- Frederick Harold Smith, 88, a resident of Helena, Alabama, passed away peacefully on Thursday, March 21, 2013. A native of Macon, he was a long time resident of Prattville, Alabama, and a member of the First United Methodist Church in Prattville before moving to Helena. He served in the United States Air Force for 28 years, logging more than 10,000 hours as a pilot before retiring as a Lieutenant Colonel in 1970. He continued next with a career as a Vice President and Loan Officer for the Bank of Prattville for 17 years before retiring again. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather and friend who will be dearly missed. He touched and inspired many lives.

He was a graduate of Lanier High School in Macon and also North Georgia College and Mercer University and received his Master's Degree from the University of Oklahoma.

He is predeceased by his wife, Dorothy (Sanders) Smith, and survived by a son Michael (Deborah) Smith, a daughter Sandra (Don) Thrasher, seven grandchildren, five great-grandchildren; and a sister, Ann (Leonard) Grace of Macon.
