“ A lot of people have been asking me for service information: For Mom's funeral rite, she chose cremation. That has to happen quick; therefore she chose not to have a traditional funeral. There was a private, informal, viewing on Sunday at the funeral home in Prattville for relatives from out of town who were unable to be with her during her final hours. When I saw my Mom then, I knew she was absent from her body (it looked terrible). My Dad & subsequently I, struggled w/ her cremation choices (even though right now that is what I have elected in writing too). I chose to accompany Mom's body to the crematory (I know her soul - and the holy spirit were absent from her body) because I wanted to honor her earthly body and ensure her ashes were interred into the urn (I watch a lot of crime shows). The crematory was a very nice, dignified place (not like I imagined it'd be). We (my daughter & I) viewed Mom again from inside a nice, comforting room through a window draped w/ nice curtains, flanked on either side by pretty art work depicting the word "Memories". The drapes opened and my Mom looked beautiful! Her body looked good! She looked happy & peaceful (I was comforted). She did not look like she was plagued w/ pancreatic cancer, COPD, or in pain anymore. After ensuring her body was contained in the crematory, the drapes closed. My daughter & I shared stories of Mom, went for a drive through the beautiful old Cloverdale historic district (she loved older, nice homes) and then we returned to ensure Mom's remains made it into the beautiful urn my dad had such a hard time picking out. When we left the crematory that evening, there was the most vibrant sunset I think that I have ever seen; I could not keep my eyes off of it as we drove & exiting into Prattville, heading on highway 14 toward their house & where soon Mom's remains will come to rest in a private above ground monument at the Prattville Memorial cemetery, I felt: "Goodbye & Welcome Home" overwhelmingly at the same time. Pulling into my parents driveway, I saw what I term "Angel portals" (sun beams through the clouds where it looks like angels could travel to & fro) beaming over their home. It was an experience I will never forget, just as I will never forget my Mom, Jane Elizabeth (Steffen) Wilson, the Best Mom ever - that I was blessed to have

personally for 47 years not only as a Mom, but as a best friend and confidant and grandma to my children. R.I.P Mom. I love you bunches!
