Through the years, at times, I’d call him for advice. I even recall doing this when I was 13 regarding problem I was disturbed about with a school teacher. I don’t even remember the details of situation but I well remember calling Uncle Jim for advice and he was there. The worse days of my life at the loss of my grandfather, my grandmother, my father and my late husband he was there, IMMEDIATELY there. The times I was hospitalized with a recurring illness over and over Uncle Jim was there. The most joyous moments of my life of weddings, the complicated pregnancy and birth of my daughter, he was there. Yet again just three months ago for her college graduation Uncle Jim was there. We asked him to say our prayer and he did. Always a steady fun, loving and supportive encouraging presence pointing to Jesus. His sweet bear hugs always provided a place of warmth and unconditional love. He loved Jesus and he loved his family. He made getting our family together a priority whether it was at his lake cabin, for a fish fry or his home or occasionally somewhere else it was a priority for him. He would call you several times to make sure you had it on your calendar and that you would be there. This was most especially true for the annual Sutherland Christmas Party and I mean like 60 plus years of a tradition. Often times we’d leave feeling like we’d all been to a revival service. He always ALWAYS pointed others to Jesus. He was never too big to admit he was wrong and come ask you for an apology even sometimes when there was no apology needed he would come to you anyway because he wanted to share his heart. His laugh and smile were contagious and he found great delight just to make you laugh. We shared numerous phone conversations where we’d pray together and for each other and they would always end with saying “I love you” to each other. I’ve always been so proud to call him MY UNCLE JIM and my life is much richer for the privilege of him being in it. He always made me feel like I was his favorite and a few years ago privately I teased him about it. His quick reply was, “huhhhh well let’s just say your up there, your up there” and I laughed. The thing is he made all of us

feel like we were his favorite niece or nephew because he loved and he loved with his whole heart.

Uncle Jim I love you always and you will forever and always hold a special place in my heart only for you. Thank you for who you were not, thank you for who you were and thank you for showing the world who HE IS!! I'll see you later on the other side. — Reba

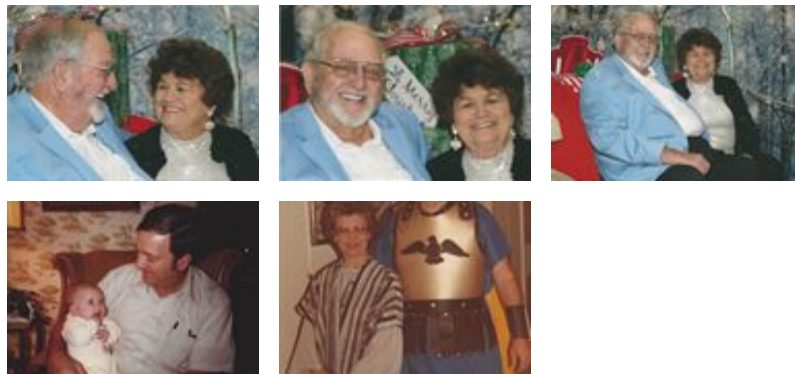
