A memorial service will be held on Sunday, August 4, 2013 at First United Methodist Church in Prattville at 3:00 p.m. with Dr. Robert Couch officiating. Shaped by the values of his parents, Kevin's powerful ethical compass was leavened by a generous heart, a sharp sense of practicality, an underlying love of people, and a gentle touch. 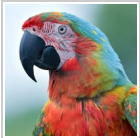
