Hansen, Kyle Steven, 27, passed away suddenly on Wednesday, February 8, 2017. Funeral services will be held on Friday, February 17, 2017 at 1:00 p.m. at the Prattville Church of Latter Day Saints chapel in Prattville located at 2200 Cobbs-Ford Road, with President Quinn Millington presiding and Bishop Greg Spears officiating.
