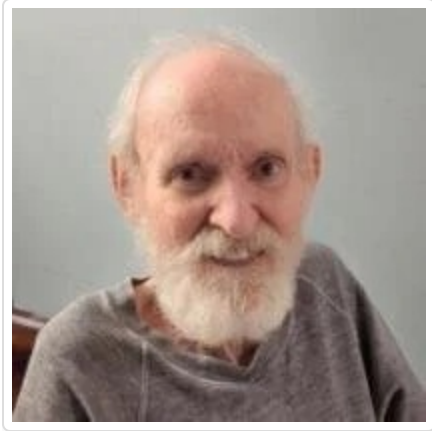




Thomas Mack Meadows
